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<p>Class Description ESAL 0420 is an Advanced Grammar class at TRU. There are 12 students in total from different cultural backgrounds. As some students are located internationally, it is important to consider how the time difference may affect their participation. The lesson for Monday, November 2, 2020, will focus on the review of the previous units.</p>
<p>Terminal Objective <i>Students will be able to...</i> Review tenses, passives, and clauses.</p>
<p>Enabling Objectives Differentiate between phrases and clauses. Practice using tenses and passives.</p>

Procedures/ Activity	What is the TEACHER doing?	What are the STUDENTS doing?
Warm-Up Activity 15 minutes	Matching worksheet on clauses and phrases. Teachers will read aloud the instructions then sentences one at a time.	Students will work together as a class to determine which definitions and sentences pertain to a phrase and which ones are clauses.
Activity 1 25 minutes	Teachers will assign students to 4 groups. Teachers will ask groups one at a time a category question. If the students answer correctly, the teacher will award the appropriate amount of points. If the students answer incorrectly, points will be subtracted from that group.	Students will work together in their groups to discuss which category and for how many points they want to answer. Once a category is picked, students will discuss in their group to determine the answer.
Closing Activity 10 minutes	Ask the students to create 2 sentences about themselves containing an adjective clause. Students will be asked to share with the class.	To be dismissed from class, students will be asked to write 2 sentences about themselves containing an adjective clause. Students

		will be asked to share their responses with the class.
